ADELAIDE STAMPEX 2010

The 3 day Adelaide Stampex 2010 was a resounding success. The venue was great. Peter Goers from 891 ABC Radio opened the show on the Friday morning with his usual entertaining flair.

Being the second Half National held in 2010, 58 the exhibit classes on offer were those not shown in Canberra last March. The viewing public were able to see multiple entries in all classes, these being Postal History (including Marcophily plus Historical, Social & Special Studies), Open Philately, Polar Philately, First Day Covers, Frugal Philately, Cinderella Philately, Philatelic Literature (including a Youth Experimental Class), Youth Philately and 24 Picture Postcard Entries (One Frame and Multi-Frame).

For the first time, two explanatory frames of one or two pages gave a brief overview of the different national classes of exhibiting. These provided an explanation concerning each class and it is hoped that this new initiative helped the viewing public to better understand what they were seeing.

There were also two multi-frame invited exhibits, and each judge was also idisplayed a single frame exhibit of their choice.

There was a team of 10 to judge the philatelic classes and a team of 6 to judge the picture postcards. The philatelic jury included two overseas judges, one from the USA and one from New Zealand who each brought exhibits of both quality and quantity to enhance the exhibition.

The high quality of material on display was reflected by the awarding of medals
Philatelic entries - 3 Large Gold, 9 Gold, 4 Large Vermeil, 11 Vermeil, 12 Large Silver, 11 Silver, 7 Silver-Bronze & 1 Bronze.

Postcard entries – 1 L Gold, 6 L Vermeil, 9 Vermeil, 3 L Silver, 4 Silver & 1 Bronze.

Grand Award – Geoffrey Lewis (Australia)

Grand Award National – Janet Klug (USA)

Grand Award International – Robin Gwynn (NZ)

Grand Award Picture Postcards – David John (Australia)

There were 13 dealers in attendance, local, overseas and from other mainland states. All were pleased with the results of the show. A new initiative was the Best Dealer's Stand Award, which was judged with the assistance of two "secret shoppers" not known to any of the dealers that did the rounds of the stallholders.

The inaugural winner was John Pearson from Pittwater Stamps who received his engraved beer tankard at the Palmares Dinner on the Saturday night.

He gave many displays and ran several quizzes, An unconventional collector of overprinted stamps, especially from North African and war-torn Middle Eastern Countries. Dave shared winning the annual competition with this material.

The Churches of Christ, in South Australia, benefited from the sale of stamps from David, accumulated when he traveled interstate attending exhibitions or 'at homes' or when manning a stall. He alone raised almost \$150, for the cause.

Dave was carer for his wife until she passed away some years ago. David was in his mid eighties.
